

Dr. V's 630's Science Weekly Summary
Week of February 12th 2018

Monday Feb 12th: Students took their Weather Unit Final TEST.

Tuesday Feb 13th: Students discussed the 6 Characteristics of Living Things. Students worked on the second page of the assignment "What is Alive" that they received in GC on Friday. Students were given a new assignment but told to only visit the website and explore the videos and articles they can find on the website.

Wednesday Feb 14th: We reviewed the expectations for the new assignment. Students were shown how to view the videos and that the 2nd column should contain one or two of the Characteristics of Living Things (Claim) and the 3rd column would contain the description (Evidence) that demonstrates the characteristic you think you saw.

Thursday Feb 15th: Students turned in their repetitions of the 6 Characteristics of living things. Students then opened up the new GD they received through GC. I asked students to recall the 6 Characteristics they had repeated yesterday and to type them out in the GD. Most were able to recall all 6, we talked about the value of rewriting notes and how many were surprised they could recall all 6 correctly. We watched the "Cell Theory" video from my website and we talked about the importance of the microscope in helping us to learn about cells. We learned about the history of the Cell Theory and students were then asked to write all 3 parts of the Cell Theory in the new GD they received through GC.

Friday Feb 16th: Students watched a video on the Amazing power of the human brain. This was an introduction to our next unit we will start in March. Enjoy your vacation.
