

Dr. V's 630's Science Weekly Summary
Week of May 7th 2018

Monday May 7th: Students continued to work on their Muscular system notes.

Tuesday May 8th: Students participated in a muscle lab.

Wednesday May 9th: Students finished their muscle lab and we talked about the paragraph they will write in a new google doc for their discussion. The discussion will include the answer to the 5 questions at the end of the lab. Students should tell me what they learned from the lab about muscles and how they work. It should include a sentence that tells me what their hypothesis was and if it was proven correct or incorrect and why they think that was.

Students will also turn in a graph (one per student) including their data and that of their partner.

There is a link on my links page that will help them get full credit for their graph. This will be turned into the homework bin tomorrow.

Thursday May 10th: Students were prompted to turn in their finished graphs and were reminded of my expectation that discussion paragraphs were turned in through GC. Students finished the muscle system notes. We started to explore the digital textbook. Students were reminded that their login was their full email address and their password was the capital letter "A" followed by their 6 digit student number (lunch code/library code).

Friday May 11th: (Posters are due) Students started work in Smartbook, an assisted reading tool that students have access to through the digital textbook. I requested that students bring in a small pot for planting. If students have a few seeds they can bring these in as well.
